

Clark's Belly Wrap for 18" waist, 17 lbs. dachshund (includes a 3" overlap)

Supplies:

- 9" velcro hook and loop, 1/4 yard fabric
- Pre-shrink fabric: wet fabric and put in dryer
- Cut 3" lengths of velcro

Make a newspaper pattern based on photo included. Try it on your dog so you can see if you need to extend the narrow ends or possibly pinch out the wide end to make smaller. You can also redo the curve to match your dog's body.

Directions:

1. Cut 2. Extend narrow end if your dog has bigger waist.
2. Sew right sides together leaving 4" on the long straight side open for turning. Use a 1/4" seam.
3. Turn right side out and press
4. Sew 1/8" all around the edge making sure you catch the 4 inch "turn opening" closed.
5. Sew all the Velcro hook pieces on one end (see picture)
6. Sew all the Velcro loop pieces on the OTHER SIDE at the end (see picture)

NOTE:

The Velcro loop side is worn facing the dog's skin. The curved edge of the wrap is oriented toward the chest.

The curved design of this style of wrap gives the penis area more coverage. Using "Always" brand super long w/ wings has basically cut out any leakage onto the band and cut laundry way down.
